2. SUMMARY: HABIB AND DRAPER MET TODAY, APRIL 24, FOR SOME 90 MINUTES WITH PRES GEMAYEL, WHO WAS ALONE. IN PART QTHE DISCUSSION FOCUSED ON THE THRUST OF THE COMMENTS MADE BY DAVID KIMCHE DURING OUR MEETING WITH HIM IN TEL AVIV ON APR 23, DURRNG WHICH KIMCHE EXPRESSED HIS GOVT'S SHOCK OVER GEMAHEL'S PRESS STATMENT OF APR 22. GEMAYEL WAS UNAPOLEGETIC ABOUT HIS PRESS STATMENT ALTHOUGH HE ADMITTED MANY COMMENTS WERE BASICALLY EXTEMPORANEOUS AND SPONTANEOUS. HE SAID HE FELT THAT ISRAEL AND LEBANON WERE NATURAL ALLIES AND SHOULD ESTABLISH A COMMON STRATEGY, BUT LEBANON COULD NOT ACCEPT THE DEGREE OF NORMALIZAUTION SOUGHT BY ISRAEL NOR COULD IT HURT ITS SOVEREIGNTY AND INDEPENDENCE BY ACCEDING TO A SOLUTION ON HADDAD IMPOSED BY ISRAEL. IN ADDITION, HE EXPLAINED HIS DEEP REESERVATIONS ABOUT THE JOINT SUPERVISORY TEAMS, CONSIDERING THEM A DE FACTO RESIDUAL PRESENCE.

3. HABIE STRESSED THAT THE ISRAELIS WERE CONCERNED DEEPLY THAT LEBANON WAS RETREATING FROM POSITIONS ALREADY AGREED TO. HABIB EXPLORED — ON THE BASIS OF KIMCHE'S HINTS — WHETHER HADDAD COULD BE GIVEN SOME SIGNIFICANT GOPERATIONAL RESPONSIBIL—ITIES UNDER AN "ADJUSTED "MODEL FORMULA". GEMAYEL DID NOT WANT TO DISCUSS THE SUBJECT AND FELT HE HAD A BETTER SOLUTION FOR ISRAEL'S CONCERNS THROUGH THE APPOINTMENT OF LAF OFFICERS OF SUPERIOR MILITARY ABILITY IN SOUTH LEBANON. AS FOR THE JOINT TEAMS, HAEIB AND DRAPER STRESSED THAT THE MILITARY COMMITTEE SHOULD BE GIVEN RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR MANAGEMENT, WHERE AND WHEN, AND TO WHICH AIMS THEY WOULD BE USED. HABIB STRRSSED THE NEED FOR FURTHER SECRET DISCUSSIONS BETWEEN THE RESPECTIVE

WE SECURED GEMAYEL'S AGREEMENT THAT, WHATEVER THE OUTCOME OF THE SUNDAY CABINET MEETING IN ISRAEL, LEBANON WOULD DO NOTHING TO SUSPEND OF BREAK OFF NEGOTIATIONS. END SUMMARY 4. DURING GEMAYEL'S MEETING WITH US ON APRIL 24, HE ASKED ABOUT PLANS FOR THE SEC'S VISITS TO BEIRUT. HABIB SAID THAT THE SEC-RETARY WOULD PROBABLY WANT TO COME TO BEIRUT ON THURSDAY MORNING FOR WORKING MEETINGS. WHILE EXACT ARRANGEMENTS WOULD HAVE TO BE COMPLETED WITH AMB DILLON, HABIB SAID HE SUSPECTED THAT THE SECRETARY WOULD NOT REMAIN OVERNIGHT BUT MIGHT WELL RETURN ON SATURDAY, FOLLOWING FRIDAY'S SESSIONS IN ISRAEL. AND CON-CEIVABLY CONTINUE A SHUTTLE THEREAFTER. THE FOCUS OF HIS ME TRIP, HABIS STRESSED, WAS THE SITUATION IN LEBANON. 5. HABIB SAID THAT HE, DRAPER, AND AMB LEWIS HAD MET WITH KIMCHE ON FRIDAY, AND THAT KIMCHE HAD EXPRESSED HIS GOVT'S SHOCK OVER THE THRUST OF GEMAYEL'S APRIL 22 STATEMENT TO EDITORS. GEMAYEL WAS UNAPOLEGETIC. WHILE HE HAD MADE EXTEMPORANEOUS STATEMENTS THAT REKFLECTED HIS VIEWS ACCURATELY. HE HAD GENUINELY SERIOUS PROBLEMS. NEVERTHELESS, HE CONSIDERED ISRAEL AND LEBANON AS NATURAL ALLIES. THE TWO COUNTRIES SHOULD ESTABLISH A COMMON STRATEGY. ISRAEL HAD TO UNDERSTAND, HOWEVER, THAT LEBANON COULD NOT ACCEPT THE DEGREE OF NORMALIZATION SOUGHT BY ISRAEL, SINCE THE ARAB WORLD WOULD THEN BOYCOTT LEBANON. OVER THE LONG RUN, HE ADDED, LEBANON WOULD, OF COURSE, BE ABLE TO ARRANGE TRADE AND INTERCOURSE ALONG LINES MORE ACCEPTABLE TO ISRAEL.

6. CONTINUING, GEMAYEL SAID THAT ISRAEL'S ATTEMPTS TO IMPOSE ITS OWN SCLUTION AS REGARDS HADDAD WAS AN ATTACK ON LEBANESE SOVEREIGNTY AND INDEPENDENCE, AND ALSO WOULD WORK AGAINST THE MORALE AND EFFICIENCY OF THE LAF. ISRAEL'S CONCEPT OF THE JOINT SUPERVISORY TEAMS WAS IN THE SAME CATEGORY, HE SAID. LEBANON COULD NOT TOLERATE A RESIDUAL IDF PRESENCE. SUMMING UP, HE SAID THAT THESE ISSUES WERE LEBANESE PROBLEMS; THEY DID NOT REFLECT AN ARAB WORLD POSITION AS SUCH. HE WANTED TO AVOID A SITUATION WHICH WOULD PROVOKE POPULAR LEBANESE OPPOSITION AGAINST THE ISRAELIS.

7. HABIE SAID THAT THE ISRAELIS, AS OF FRIDAY, DID NOT HAVE THE EXACT TEXT OF GEMAYEL'S REMARKS TO THE PRESS. HAVING READ THEM JUST BEFORE THIS MEETING, HE SAID QHE THOUGHT THAT GEMAYEL'S VIEWS WERE NOT AS NEGATIVE TOWARDS THE ISRAELI POSITIONS AS HE HAD BEEN TOLD. HE THEN REVIEWED THE MEETING WITH KIMCHE IN SOME DETAIL DURING WHICH HE HAD URGED KIMCHE NOT TO CONSIDER BREAKING OFF THE NEGOTIATIONS THIS WEEK. 8. AT BOTTOM, HABBIB SAID THE ISRAELIS DEEPLY FEARED THAT THE LEBANKESE WERE REVERSING TYHE PATH ON WHICH THEY HAD UNDERTAKEN THE NEGOTIATIONS. THE ISRAELIS FEARED THAT THE LEBANESE WERE BACKING AWAY FROM POSITIONS THEY HAD ALREADY AGREED TO. THAT WAS WHY IT WAS VITALLY IMPORTANT THAT LEBANON CONTINUE TO ACCEPT IN PRICIPLE SUCH CONCCEPTS AS JOINT SUPERVISORY ATROLS WHILE WORKING IN THE NEGOTIATONS TO LIMIT THEIR SCOPE, WHEN NECESSARY, AND THEIR VISIBLITY.

9. IN A DEFENSIVE WAY, GEMAYEL SAID THAT BEGIN AND ARENS HAD MADE ALL KINDS OF CAUSTIC STATEMENTS ABOUT LEBANON AND LEBANON SK CAPACITY. THERE WAS NO REASON WHY LEBANON'S LEADERS, LIKE HIMSELF, SHOULD NOT CULARIFY THEIR OWN POSITIONS. HADDAD WAS A GOOD CASE IN POINT. HADDAD BASICALLY WAS A PROBLEM FOR LEBANON ALONE, HE SKTRESSED, ALTHOUGH YHE WAS READY FOR A REASONABLE SOLUTION WITHIN A BROAD PACKAGE PLAN. RETURNING TO THE JOINT TEAMS, HE STRESSED THAT THE ISRAELIS HAD AGAIN STRESSED THE CONCEPT OF "HOT PURSUIT" AND "JOINT OPERATIONS". HE COULD NOT LIVE WITH SUCH CONCPTS. HE WENT ON TO SAY THAT HE HAD JUSTIFIED SOME OF THE EXISTING LEBANESE POSITIONS IN HIS PRESS COMMENTARY BYYLIKENING THE PROPOSED MILITARY COMMITTEE TO THE MIXED ARMISTICE COMMISSION. HABIB REMARKED THAT MENTION OF A MIXED ARMISTICE COMMISSION WAS A RED FLAG TO THE ISRAELIS. GEMAYEL SAID HE WOULD NOT WILLINGLY AGREE TO FURTHER CONCESSIONS TO THE ISRAELIS, EXCEPT WITHIN A PACKAGE PLAN. THIS INCLUDED THE USE OF APC'S BY THE TEAMS.

10. CITING SOME OF WHAT HAS ALREADY COME OUT OF THE NEGOTIATIONS, HABIB AND DRAPER STRESSED THE SAFETY FEATURES OF ALLOWING THE MILITARY COMMMTTEE TO MAKE THE DECISIONS ON THE USE OF THE TEAMS, THEIR NUMBER, SCOPE OF ACTIVIY, ETC.

11. HHABIE PROPOSED GEMAYEL HARD ABOUT A NEW KIND OF SOLUTION FOR THE HADDAD PROBLEM, BBASING HIS COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

ON HINTS GIVEN THE DAY PREVIOUSLY BY KIMCHE TO THE EFFECT THAT A NEW "MODEL FORMULA" MIGHT BE CONSIDERED IN AN OPEN-MINDED WAY. HABIB SUGGESTED THAT THE ISRAGELIS MIGHT BE ENTRANCED IF HADDAD HAD SOME OPERATIONAL AS OPPOSED TO THE STAFF RESPONSIBILITY. COULD HADDAD'S PROPOSED ROLE AS A BIGADE DEPCOMMANDER IN CHARGE OF G-2 BE MANIPULATED SO AS TO GIVE HIM CONTROL OVER SOME LIMITED STRIKE FORCE, FOR EXAMPLE? 12. GEMAYEL DID NOT WANT TO TALK FURTHER ABOUT HADDAD. HE SAID THATTHE AND GEN TANNOUS HAD SOME OFFICERS IN MIND FOR LEADERSHIP ROLES IN SOUTHERN LEBANON, BUT HE WAS AFRAID THAT THE ISRAELIS WOULD CAUSE EMBARRASSMENTS IF THEKSE NAMES WERE GIVEN TO THE ISRAELIS NOW. THESE MEN, HOWEVER, GEMAYEL SAID, WERE MORE EFFICIENT MILITARILY THAN HADDAD. THIS WAS THE SOLUTION. GEMAYEL WENT ON TO VOICE SUSPICIONS OF ISRAEL'S MOTIVATIONS ABOUT HADDAD, WHO HE CLALAIMED WAS IN EFFECT A PRISONER OF THE ISRAELIS. RATHER THAN GIVE IN TO THE ISRAELIS ON THIS MATTER, HE SAID HE WOULD PREFER TO LET THEM STAY IN SOUTH LEBANON. 13. HABIB SAID THAT HE COULD NOT LET GEMAYEL STOP WORKIIG FORA A SOLUTION TO HADDAD AND OTHER PROBLEMS. GEMAYEL SAID THE PROBLEM FOR HIM AND LEBANON WAS "TO BE OR NOT TO BE." THE KTEST WAS SOUTH LEBANON. IF LEBANON COULD NOT RECURE A GOOD SOLUTION IN THE SOUTH, AND MAINTAIN ITS CREDIBILITY, THEN THERE WOULD BE IMPLICATIOUNS FOR OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY, WHILE THE IRANIANS, SYRIANS, COMMUNISITS AND THE PLO TRIED TO TAKE ADVANTAGUE. 14. AFTER FURTHER EXCAHNGE OF VIEWS TO IMPROVE WAYS TO PERSUADE TWHE ISRAELIS TO A MORE ACCOMMODATING POSITION VIS-A-VIS LEBANON, HABIB URGED THAT LEBANON AND ISRAEL STEP UP THEIR CON-SULTATIONS ON INTELLIGENCE COOPERATION. AFTER HE ASKED ABOUT THE RESULTS OF THE LAST SUCH MEETINGS BY THE RESPECTIVE INTELL-IGENCE AND SECURITY SERVICES, GEMAYEL ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THEY HAD "NOT BEEN TOO POSITIVE."

THE MEETING CONCLUDED WITH AGREEMENT THAT WE SHOULD REMAIN IN CLOSE TOUCH, PARTICUARLY THROUGHOUT THE FORTHCOMING VIGSITS OF THE SECRETARY TO ISRAEL AND LEBANON. GEMAYEL RETURNED TO THE THEME THAT THE ISRAELIS WERE INSISTENT ON KMAINTAINING A MPLITARY PRESENCE IN SOUTHERN LEBANON "ON THE GROUND." THIS ISRAELI DESIRE, IF SATISFIED, WOULD INEVITABLY CRKEATE STRONG ANTI-ISRAELI SENTIMENTT AND ATTITUDES, WHILE ALSO PROVOKING THE SYRIANS TO RETREAT FROM THEIR PREVIOUS UNDERSTANDINGS. THE REAL SOLUTION FOR ISRAEL WAS TO LOWER ITS PRESENCE AND CUT BACK ON UITDS DEMANDS SO THAT ISRAEL AND LEBANON COULD WORK COOPERATIVELY IN A QUIET ATMOSPHERE FOR THE OBJECTIVES THEY BOTH SOUGHT. HE ASKED THAT THE MERCHANTS BE RELEASED, THE MAY 7 DEADLINE RESCINDED, AND NON-PERISHABLE GOODS RELEASED.

6. IN REPLY, FATTAL STATED THAT LEBANON WAS AS DEDICATED AS ISRAEL TO REACHING AN ACCORD. HE COMMENTED THAT IF ONE EXAMINED HIS PRESIDENT'S DECLARATION IN ITS WHOLE—AND NOT IN ITS DETAILS—IT COULD BE

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SEEN THAT THIS WAS ALSO THE MOOD WHICH PRESIDENT GEMAYEL HAD EXPRESSED. 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C O N F I D E N T I A L SECTION 03 OF 05 TEL AVIV 05616 EXDIS ING REVISION TO THE LAST SENTENCE OF ARTICLE 7: IT NOW READS: GUOTE NEW CONTRIBUTORS TO SUCH FORCES SHALL BE SELECTED FROM AMONG STATES WHICH HAVE DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH BOTH PARTIES TO THE PRESENT AGREEMENT. END QUOTE. KIMCHE THEN RAISED THE QUESTION OF THOSE UNIFIL CONTINGENTS PRESENTLY IN LEBANON WHICH DO NOT HAVE DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH ISRAEL OR LEBANON. FIVN, SENEGAL AND NIGERIA FALL INTO THIS CATEGORY. IT WAS AGREED THAT THIS ISSUE WOULD BE LEFT OPEN FOR THE MOMENT AND POSSIBLY HANDLED LATER BY AN AGREED MINUTE. FATTAL OBSERVED THAT ONE HAD TO BE CAREFUL TO AVOID A COLLISION WITH THE U.N. SYSTEM ON THIS MATTER.

## ARTICLE 8

11. THERE WAS SOME DISCUSSION OF THE NAME WHICH WOULD BE GIVEN TO THE MILITARY COMMITTEE (PARAGRAPH 1(C) OF ARTICLE 8). IN ORDER TO SPEED THINGS ALONG, KIMCHE SUGGESTED THAT THE GROUP BE NAMED THE "SECURITY COMMITTEE." DRAPER THOUGHT THIS WAS AN ACCEPTABLE COMPROMISE, BUT THE LEBANESE PREFERRED TO RESERVE THEIR POSITION. SOME OTHER MINOR DRAFTING CHANGES WERE ALSO AGREED TO IN THIS ARTICLE. WITH RESPECT TO THE AMERICAN PROPOSAL THAT CLAIMS LANGUAGE BE ADDED (ARTICLE 8, PARAGRAPH 2), KIMCHE SAID THAT HIS GOVERNMENT WAS STILL CONSIDERING THIS MATTER.

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ECONOMIC BOYCOTT LANGUAGE

12. KIMCHE SAID HE WOULD LIKE TO ADD THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH TO ARTICLE 8 IN ORDER TO STRENGTHEN THE PROVISION WITH RESPECT TO THE ECONOMIC BOYCOTT. (NOTE: THIS PARAGRAPH IS A REVISED FORMULATION OF THE LEBANESE LANGUAGE CONTAINED IN ARTICLE 11 OF THEIR DRAFT.)

BEGIN TEXT:

-- EACH OF THE PARTIES WILL TAKE, UPON ENTRY
-- INTO FORCE OF THE AGREEMENTS PROVIDED FOR
-- IN SUB-PARAGRAPH "A" OF THIS PARAGRAPH, AND
-- NOT LATER THAN ONE YEAR FROM THE ENTRY INTO
-- FORCE OF THE PRESENT AGREEMENT, ALL NECESSARY
-- MEASURES, IN CONFORMITY WITH ITS CONSTITUTIONAL
-- PROCEDURES, FOR THE ABROGATION OF LAWS AND
-- REGULATIONS WHICH ARE NOT COMPATIBLE WITH THE
-- PRESENT ARTICLE OR THE ABOVEMENTIONED AGREEMENTS,
-- OR WHICH IMPEDE THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY PASSAGE
-- OF GOODS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES.

FOR THE SAME REASON, KIMCHE ALSO ASKED THAT A FURTHER PARAGRAPH BE INCLUDED UNDER ARTICLE 8 WHICH WOULD STATE THAT EACH PARTY WILL REFRAIN FROM ACTIONS WHICH WOULD HARM THE ECONOMY OF THE OTHER PARTY.

13. FATTAL STATED THAT HE COULD NOT ACCEPT THESE PROPOSALS FOR REASONS WHICH HE HAD PREVIOUSLY EXPLAINED. HE INDICATED THAT THIS WAS A MOST DELICATE ISSUE AND HIS GOVERNMENT DID NOT WANT THE BOYCOTT TO BE SUPPRESSED TOO CLEARLY IN THE LANGUAGE OF THE AGREEMENT. HE ALSO NOTED THAT WHEN ONE EMPLOYED PHRASEOLOGY THAT TRADE WOULD BE ON A "NON-DISCRIMINATORY" BASIS, THIS MADE ANY OTHER REFERENCE TO THE BOYCOTT SUPERFLUOUS. SUGGESTED A POSSIBLE COMPROMISE IN THE FORM OF AN AGREED MINUTE TO THE AGREEMENT. WHICH WOULD READ: QUOTE: IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THIS PROVISION SHOULD APPLY MUTATIS MUTANDIS TO AGREEMENTS CONCLUDED BY BOTH PARTIES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 8. PARAGRAPH 2. UNQUOTE. KIMCHE REPLIED THAT THIS LANGUAGE WOULD STILL BE CONTINGENT ON A FINAL AGREEMENT BEING REACHED; AND RUBENSTEIN UNDERSCORED MY POINT BY SAYING THAT ISRAEL WANTS THE BOYCOTT TO BE ABROGATED WHETHER OR NOT THE FINAL NEGOTIATIONS ON MUTUAL RELATIONS ARE CONCLUDED. IT WAS AGREED THAT THIS ISSUF WOULD BE HELD IN ABEYANCE.

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TO MAINTAIN THE INITIAL LANGUAGE ON PARAGRAPH 1, ARTICLE 10, AS OPPOSED TO THE AMERICAN FORMULA WHICH STATES THAT QUOTE THE AGREEMENT WOULD REMAIN IN FORCE UNTIL THE TREATY OF PEACE BETWEEN THE PARTIES IS FORMALLY CONCLUDED. END QUOTE. KINCHE STATED THAT ISRAEL ALSO PREFERRED ITS ORIGINAL FORMULATION, BUT WAS STILL CONSULTING ABOUT THE AMERICAN PROPOSITION. IT WAS ALSO AGREED AT FATTAL'S SUGGESTION TO REVISE PARAGRAPH 2 TO READ: QUOTE: THE PRESENT AGREEMENT OF THE TWO PARTIES."

### ARTICLE 11

15. ASIDE FROM THE EARLIER DISCUSSION BY THE ISRAELI SIDE WHICH WOULD MOVE THE FIRST PARAGRAPH OF ARTICLE 11 (THE ABROGATION OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS) TO ARTICLE 8, BOTH SIDES AGREED TO REVISE THE SECOND PARAGRAPH TO READ: "THE PARTIES UNDERTAKE NOT TO APPLY EXISTING OBLIGATIONS, ENTER INTO ANY OBLIGATION, OR ADOPT LAWS OR REGULATIONS IN CONFLICT WITH THE PRESENT AGREEMENT." THE ISRAELI SIDE WANTED THIS LANGUAGE TO BE INCLUDED IN ORDER TO MAKE IT CLEAR THAT THIS AGREEMENT WOULD TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER LEBANON'S OBLIGATIONS TO THE ARAB DEFENSE PACT.

ARTICLE 13

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16. FATTAL PROPOSED NEW LANGUAGE FOR PARAGRAPH ONE RELATING TO THE RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES. BEGIN TEXT:

ANY DISPUTE ARISING BETWEEN THE PARTIES
CONCERNING THE INTERPRETATION OR APPLICATION
OF THE PRESENT AGREEMENT, WHICH IS NOT
SETTLED BY NEGOTIATION IN THE JOINT LIAISON

COMMITTEE, SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO CONCILIATION, AND IF NOT SO RESOLVED, TO AN AGREED PROCEDURE

FOR A DEFINITIVE SETTLEMENT.

#### END TEXT.

KIMCHE STATED THAT THIS LANGUAGE WAS ACCEPTABLE PROVIDED THAT IT BEGAN WITH THE WORDING QUOTE: ANY UNRESOLVED DISPUTE UNQUOTE. FATTAL STRONGLY RESISTED SUCH AN ADDITION, ARGUING THAT THIS WOULD ESTABLISH ANOTHER LEVEL OR PHASE IN NEGOTIATING DIS-PUTES. DESPITE SOME COMPROMISE SUGGESTIONS OFFERED BY DRAPER, FATTAL REFUSED TO BE BUDGED AND IT WAS FINALLY AGREED TO SET THIS ISSUE ASIDE FOR THE MOMENT. FATTAL ALSO DISAGREED WITH THE ISRAELI SUGGESTION THAT THE PROVISIONS FOR THE RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES FALLING UNDER THE SECURITY ANNEX (PARAGRAPH 2) SHOULD ALSO INCLUDE ARTICLES 4 AND 6 OF THE COVERING AGREEMENT. THE ISRAELIS ARGUED THAT THESE TWO ARTICLES WERE OF A SECURITY NATURE AND SHOULD BE DEALT WITH IN THE FIRST INSTANCE WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE MILITARY COMMITTEE. THIS ISSUE WAS NOT RESOLVED.

# AGREED MINUTES

17. BOTH SIDES AGREED TO THE AGREED MINUTES FOR THE COVERING AGREEMENT.
INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS

18. IN A SIDE MEETING, AMBASSADOR KHARMA DISCUSSED INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS WITH RUBENSTEIN AND KOZAK. HE SAID HE STILL DID NOT HAVE ANY FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE MOVEMENT OF GOODS, ESPECIALLY ON THE QUESTION OF "POSITIVE" VERSUS "NEGATIVE" LISTS. THE ISRAELIS PRESSED FOR CONCRETE ARRANGEMENTS TO ENSURE THAT THE INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS WOULD BE IMPLEMENTED ON THE GROUND; AND THEY PRESENTED A DRAFT TO COVER THESE POINTS. KHARMA, AS HE HAD DONE DURING THE LAST MEETING IN KHALDAH, FUDGED AND SAID HE WAS WITHOUT INSTRUCTIONS. HE ALSO HAD DIFFICULTIES WITH THE ISRAELI

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PROPOSALS WHICH WOULD SPECIFY THOSE AREAS TO BE COVERED DURING THE NEGOTIATIONS ON THE FINAL AGREEMENT(S) ON MUTUAL RELATIONS, INCLUDING SUCH AREAS AS CULTURAL RELATIONS. KOZAK TOLD KHARMA THAT IT WAS VERY IMPORTANT FOR LEBANON TO BE AT LEAST IN THE POSITION BT #5616
