OCTOBER 12, 1984

DEAR MARGARET,

WORD OF THE BRIGHTON ATTACK REACHED ME LATE LAST NIGHT, FOLLOWED IMMEDIATELY BY THE MOST WELCOME NEWS THAT YOU WERE UNHARMED. NOW I HAVE BEEN TOLD OF DEATHS AND INJURIES, AND PARTICULARLY OF THE GRIEVIOUS WOUNDS TO YOUR COLORAGUES.

AS WE RECOGNIZED IN LONDON DURING THE SUMMIT, TERRORIST VIOLENCE IS BECOMING INCREASINGLY INDISCRIMINATE AND BRUTAL. BECAUSE ACTS SUCH AS THE ONE LAST NIGHT ARE A GROWING THREAT TO ALL DEMOCRACIES, WE MUST WORK TOGETHER TO THWART THIS SCOURGE AGAINST HUMANITY. IN THE CONTEXT OF OUR SPECIAL RELATIONSHIP, I HAVE DIRECTED THAT MY EXPERTS BE AVAILABLE TO WORK WITH YOURS TO ASSISTED AND BRINGING THE PERPETRATORS

- 2. Am especially happy that you were not personally injured. Please extend my wishes for a speedy recovery to those injured.
- 3. This deplorable act again demonstrates that we must do all we can to stop terrorism. A dedicated terrorist will always have some success, but we must make their task difficult.
- 4. On a seperate manner. I received your letter on the Gromyko meeting and share your hope that it will mark the beginning of a new phase in our efforts to engage the Soviets in constructive dialogue.
